The church is committed to church planting and nurturing new believers, especially in unreached villages and urban mission fields. We also visited some new Buddhist families, built friendships with them, and had opportunities to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Providing some assistance to 20 families who have been displaced because of the civil war in the country. They had to leave their native places and flee to Yangon, where they are now trying to rebuild their lives. Two little girls lost their mother to cancer. They are now living with their father, and their aunt takes very close care of them. Pastor Tun and his wife visited the family and offered some support by providing clothes and rice. We also spent time praying with them and encouraging them during this difficult season.



The church was able to provide a small amount of financial support to build a pathway using sandbags, so that people in the community could walk and travel more safely and easily. Through our evangelistic outreach, we have also been able to connect with the people in the community. We are thankful that many of them are now coming to the church every Sunday to worship and hear God's Word.



Pastor Tun Lin, his wife, and his colleague visited Daw Cho Htoo Mar, who has been hospitalized. She is the one who has been learning about Christ and has attended church several times. They also provided some financial support to help with the cost of her medications.
